Pt. Madan Oak, is a senior disciple of the world-renowned Santoor Maestro Late Padma Vibhushan Pandit Shivkumar Sharma.

Madanji has been studying Indian classical music for over 40 years and has won several college and University level awards in Classical music competitions He is a recipient of the 1986 All India Radio (AIR) Best Instrumentalist National award and has been felicitated with a "Kala-Gaurav" award and a "Guru-Satkar" award recognition by Pt. Hridaynath Mangeshkar

Madan ji has given many concerts in America, UK, Switzerland, India, Dubai and Abu Dhabi Living in America for more than 30 years he has led IT Business as profession, he has been featured on many TV programs and a long list of various music festivals.

Apart from playing Santoor, he is also a gifted vocalist and is an ardent fan of soulful voice of Mohd. Rafi sahab. Madan ji released his first classical music album "Moonlit Strings" in 2010 at the hands of the respected Late Pandita Smt. Veena Sahastrabuddhe, a highly regarded Indian classical music vocalist. The album was blessed and endorsed by his Guru Pt. Shivkumar Sharma.

To give exposure of Indian classical Music and Dance to local bay area California children, Madan ji started Shatatantri Media an academy of Indian classical music in 2006 and is affiliated with Gandharva Mahavidyalaya of India and conducts Indian classical music certification examinations as well.
